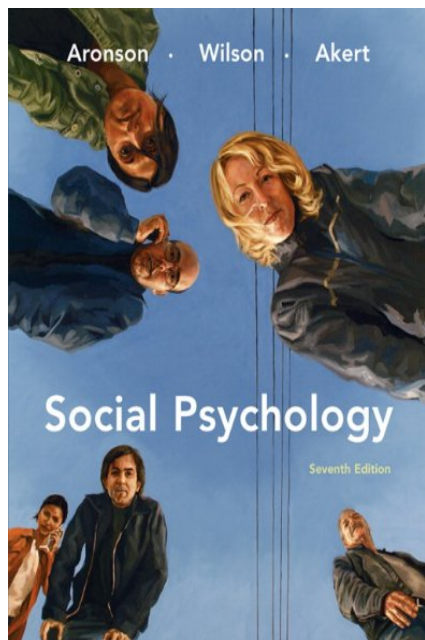

He is currently Professor Emeritus at the University of California at Santa Cruz and Distinguished Visiting Professor at Stanford University. Dr. Aronson is the only person in the 110-year history of the American Psychological Association to have received all three of its major awards for distinguished writing, distinguished teaching, and distinguished research. Many other professional societies have honored his research and teaching as well. He has been elected twice to the Executive Board of the Society for Experimental Social Psychology and is a Fellow in the American Psychological Society.
